- Sky Island Explorer (in development): iOS app for saving photos and drawings as journal entries along with associated data (using Magical Records, ACE-DrawingView and UIImagePicker). Project includes a website to which entries can be sent (using AFNetworking) and a back-end administration section for approving new pictures. Data is saved server side in a MySQL database and processed with PHP.
- The Loft Cinema app for iPhone/iPad: iOS app for displaying show times and news. NSURLConnection contacts Twitter/RTS APIs and the XML/JSON response is parsed with the GData class and stored using Core Data. Shows can be added to the default calendar with Event Kit. Object orientated design pattern ensured simple recent redesign to use AFNetworking, Sharekit and MagicalRecord frameworks (installed as Pods) as well as transition to v1.1 of the Twitter REST API.
- Flandrau Science Center iPad apps: a series of four multiple choice quizzes for iPad to be used by children at outreach events. Combined NSTimer, and UIBezierPath to animate highlighting of interactive areas. App settings are stored using NSUserDefaults and JDDroppableView class is used to allow drag and drop of UI elements onto specific targets. AudioToolbox and MediaPlayer frameworks control audio and visual responses to user interactions.
